#### **Gospel: Luke 17:5-10**

The apostles said to the Lord, 'Increase our faith.' The Lord replied, 'Were your faith the size of a mustard seed you could say to this mulberry tree, "Be uprooted and planted in the sea", and it would obey you.

'Which of you, with a servant ploughing or minding sheep, would say to him when he returned from the fields, "Come and have your meal immediately"? Would he not be more likely to say, "Get my supper laid; make yourself today and wait on me while I eat and drink. You can eat and drink yourself afterwards"? Must he be grateful to the servant for doing what he was told? So with you: when you have done all you have been told to do, say, "We are merely servants: we have done no more than our duty."



#### **Reflection:**

Colourful stories and wild exaggerations were part of Jesus' standard teaching repertoire. Today Luke seems to have moderated one such figure of speech. In both Matthew and Mark Jesus says that with faith his followers could throw a mountain into the sea. Luke reduces this to a mulberry tree. However, this is still a mighty feat, an imaginary instance of what could be done by those who believed that "nothing is impossible to God" (1:37).

For all the prominence Luke gives to mercy and compassion in his gospel, there are times when he takes a hard line. As we've been reminded in recent weeks, he is acutely aware of the lure of possessions and constantly warns about the dangers of wealth. Well-to-do Christian leaders may be the target of the unique story he now tells. Servants who have done their job would be foolish to expect their master to turn around and serve them. They would have forgotten their place. Community leaders too must never forget that their role is to serve, not to be served.

The two parts of this gospel text stand in complete contrast to one another. Part one opens up a panorama of the infinitely possible, part two shuts the door on illusions of self-importance. In the proclamation, a suitable pause would allow the assembly to distinguish them as two disparate units.
