

Baptism Information

Families will be called to the font. Parents hold their child accompanied by Godparents. Family and Friends are welcome to gather around the baptismal font also. Water is a rich sign of purification and life, and **the pouring of water** symbolises new life and freedom in Christ.

Father will **make the sign of the cross** on your child's forehead. The cross is a symbol for Christians remembering that Jesus died on the cross for us all. Parents and godparents are asked to trace the sign of the cross, showing that the child belongs to Christ.

Oil of Chrism (mixture of olive oil and sweet smelling balsam) is rubbed on your child's head. It is a sign of sealing with the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

A white garment or stole symbolises innocence and the new life of resurrection. A white stole is placed around the baby's neck by the godparents. We suggest you keep this stole and use again for your child's sacramental celebrations of First Eucharist and Confirmation.

Candles symbolise Christ – the light of the world and the baptismal candle reminds us that the light of Christ has entered the child's life. Godparents are called up to light the candle from the Easter candle during the ceremony.

Baptismal Certificate - you will be presented with the Baptismal Certificate as part of the ceremony. Please keep it in a safe place as it is required for enrolment into Catholic Schools and before receiving other sacraments.

Baptism Offering

Your offering allows our parish to continue our work in preparing families for Baptism, and supports our many forms of outreach.

Normal Catholic practice is to make an offering on the occasions of baptisms and weddings (called 'stole fees'). At St. Francis Xavier, Montmorency and Our Lady Help of Christians, Eltham, the offering is \$100 or more - depending on what you can afford. This goes towards Ministry and Outreach in **both** parishes.
