The presence of God

Jesus says to Peter, "Man of little faith, why did you doubt?" It is interesting as we reflect upon this scene in today's Gospel. Here is Jesus whose friends knew his power and the many gifts that he shared with them and they saw so often, afraid for their own lives. They thought they were about to drown in the huge and rough seas. They were thinking only about themselves. The words of Jesus "Courage! It is I!" Seemed to have little effect for Peter wanted proof; "Lord, if it is you, tell me to come to you across the water." Jesus simply said, "Come". Here is the impact of this event. How often you only think of yourself and your own well-being before you consider the other? How often do you look for proof when you know your relationship with God?

Jesus in this event reminds us that he is ever present to watch over and protect, to guide and nourish us. All we have to do is trust and not doubt. So perhaps our prayer today is that of Peter, "Truly you are the Son of God".

BISHOPS CALL TO PRAY FOR PEACE IN GAZA

The Australian Catholic Bishops call on parishioners across the country to pray for peace and an end to the ongoing conflict and tragedy in the Middle East and Iraq. President of the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference Archbishop Denis Hart said today: "We offer our constant prayers for the innocent victims of the current conflicts and for an end to the continuing loss of life." "Our Holy Father Pope Francis has appealed for an end to violence in the Middle East, the Australian Catholic Bishops support the Pope's call for peace between Israel and Palestine," Archbishop Hart said. The Australian Catholic Bishops support our fellow bishops in New Zealand in drawing Pope Francis' attention to the request of Father Raed, the parish priest of Holy Family Parish in Gaza who said: "I launch a humble appeal to Pope Francis: may you convene a vigil of prayer and fasting for peace in the Holy Land, as you did for Syria. All the people who inhabit this land, the land of Jesus, are tired of living in fear and pain". "We support the New Zealand Catholic Bishops in their request to the Holy See for a global prayer vigil at this time," Archbishop Hart said.
