After the Resurrection

In these days after celebrating Easter we most likely reflected upon the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. It is easy for us to contemplate how the friends of Jesus felt as they saw him die on the Cross. They were sad and grieving and at a loss for the one who had given so much to them was not with them any more. As Jesus appeared to them after the Resurrection they were at first apprehensive and afraid for they were not sure if they were seeing a ghost.

Jesus reassured them and offered his peace and consolation to help them understand and believe that indeed he had risen as he said he would.

Today's Gospel shares one of those encounters whereby Jesus not only give them peace, while at the same time sending them out with the Holy Spirit.

We also note that Thomas makes a wonderful profession of faith, "My Lord and my God" as he meets Christ upon his return.

When I was preparing to receive Holy Communion for the first time, Sr Coleman, invited us to say those same words when we received Holy Communion. To this day I say those same words. Since my Ordination I now say those words at the elevation of the host and the chalice after the consecration. This is my act of faith, my proclamation of belief in the risen Lord, now present to each one of us as we come to receive the Risen Lord in the gift of the Eucharist, as did the apostles at the Last Supper. As Jesus said to Thomas:

"You believe because you can see me. Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe."

Entrance Antiphon: Like newborn infants, you must long for the pure, spiritual milk, that in him you may grow to salvation, alleluia.

Responsorial Psalm: Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his love is everlasting.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! You believe in me, Thomas, because you have seen me; happy those who have not seen me, but still believe! Alleluia!

<u>Communion Antiphon:</u> Bring your hand and feel the place of the nails, and do not be unbelieving but believing, alleluia.
