

## NEW LIFE

Through the Prophet Ezekiel God foreshadows his own life, while offering a vision, he presents to them, new life. 'I am going to open your graves; I mean to raise you form your graves, my people, and lead you back to the soil of Israel'. Lazarus stands, in the life of Christ, as the image of that vision presented so long ago, new life, and again foreshadows the

life and death of Christ, himself.

As we draw close to the celebration of the Passion of Christ, we begin to understand how we have been so much a part of God's plan. He offers us this new life, for through his own Death and Resurrection we also rise with him to the new life of complete union with him. We hear Jesus responding to Martha:

"I am the resurrection and the life. If anyone believes in me, even though he dies he will live, And whoever lives in me will never die. Do you believe this?" **Entrance Antiphon:** Give me justice, O God, and plead my cause against a nation that is faithless. From the deceitful and cunning rescue me, for you, O God, are my strength.
