All who have completed their 18th year and have not begun their 60th year are bound to fast. All who have completed their 14th year are bound to abstain.

On all other Fridays, the we are called to perform one of the following:

Prayer: For example:- Mass attendance, family prayer, making the Stations of the Cross. **Self-denial**: For example:- not eating meat, not eating sweets, giving up entertainment, limiting food and drink, supporting Project Compassion.

Helping Others: For example:- special attention to those in need, sick, poor, elderly.
