God loved us so much!

St Paul reminds us in these words: "God loved us so much that he was generous with his mercy: when we were dead through our sins, he brought us to life with Christ - it is through grace that you have been saved".

While speaking with Nicodemus (in today's Gospel), Jesus explains his place in our own salvation, drawing on history and the events of the Israelites with Moses in the desert, to help us today understand what he has done for us. "Yes, God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life".

These remaining weeks of Lent offer us a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the impact of the love of Jesus for us, which challenges us to consider where we are on our journey. Do we ever consider the sacrifice Jesus makes for us each time we celebrate the Eucharist? Look at the sacrifices you make for those you love so dearly. Jesus is doing exactly the same, yet more perfectly, for he sacrifices himself each time we gather at Mass and receive Holy Communion.

Entrance Antiphon: Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast.

Responsorial Psalm: Let my tongue be silenced, if I ever forget you!
