Prayer of St Francis

The Prayer of St Francis is particularly relevant for us today, as we ponder the words of Jesus in our Gospel. He reminds his friends not to think of themselves and what they want, but rather to think of what they can offer:-

Lord, make me an instrument of your peace. Where there is hatred let me sow love. Where there is injury pardon. Where there is doubt faith. Where there is despair hope. Where there is darkness light and where there is sadness joy. O Divine Master grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console to be understood as to understand to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive it is in pardoning that we are pardoned and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life. **Entrance Antiphon:** To you I call; for you will surely heed me, O God; turn your ear to me; hear my words. Guard me as the apple of your eye; in the shadow of your wings protect me. **Responsorial Psalm:** Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, Alleluia! The Son of Man came to serve and to give his life as a ransom for all. Alleluia!

<u>Communion Antiphon:</u> Behold, the eyes of the Lord are on those who fear him, who hope in his merciful love, to rescue their souls from death, to keep them alive in famine.
