This is the question Jesus put to his disciples while alone with them. Peter was the one who proclaimed: 'The Christ of God'.

If Jesus was to ask you the same question, what might your answer be?

Jesus then outlines what is needed of a 'follower'. "If anyone wants to be a follower of mine, let him denounce himself and take up his cross every day and follow me. For anyone who wants to save his life will lose it; but anyone who loses his life for my sake, that man will save it." We then need to ask ourselves what does Jesus mean?
