CHURCH REFURBISHMENT PROGRAM

The Parish Leadership Team has considered all feedback regarding the proposed refurbishment of the church, and will proceed with the program originally proposed in the information sessions held in September. A model of the church showing the new sanctuary and seating layout has been prepared to visually illustrate the planned changes within the context of the existing building. The model will be on display on the sanctuary after all Masses, and pictures will be displayed in the church foyers. We invite all parishioners to have a look at the model and discuss any questions you have with Fr Peter or members of the Parish Leadership Team.

While the core elements of the design have been finalised, final details regarding fitout, screening, lighting and flooring will be finalised as the program proceeds. We expect the contract for the construction aspects of the program to be finalised shortly, with work commencing early January 2016. At this stage, we expect Masses to be celebrated as usual in the church up to Sunday 3rd January, and after that weekday Mass in the Parish Centre and weekend Masses in the Parish Hall during the refurbishment. Further details of arrangements will be provided closer to that time.

We will be providing regular information bulletins via the church and school, to keep people informed of what is happening during the refurbishment program, including a high level plan of activities once it is available. We encourage anyone who would like to discuss any aspect of the program to contact the Parish Leadership Team directly or through the Parish Office.
