# Listen

We have ears and most of us are able to hear, even though for some of us we may not be able to hear as well as we once did. Having ears means that we are able to hear the noises that are around us. Yet even though we are able to hear, let's assume we all hear, we may not always listen to what we hear. For example do we always listen to the sound of the clock ticking in the room where we are. Do we always listen to the sound of the refrigerator as it cools the food within. Do we always listen to our own breathing. Most of us would say, 'NO'. Even though we hear these sounds we do not always listen. Perhaps we may do the same when someone is talking to us. We hear them speaking, yet we may not be listening to them. It takes a conscious effort to really listen, to hear, what is being spoken.

Today our Scripture invites us to LISTEN and not just hear the Word of God. To trust in our God and know that he always listens to us. The first words of our psalm today reminds us and can be our prayer this week: "I trusted, even when I said: 'I am sorely afflicted'. So may we listen to him as he listens to us.

On all other Fridays, the we are called to perform one of the following:

**Prayer**: For example:- Mass attendance, family prayer, making the Stations of the Cross. **Self-denial**: For example:- not eating meat, not eating sweets, giving up entertainment, limiting food and drink, supporting Project Compassion.

Helping Others: For example:- special attention to those in need, sick, poor, elderly.

<u>**Project Compassion Boxes and Envelope Packs** are available, for our use during Lent, in the porches of the Church. Another way of making a sacrifice during Lent.</u>
