**Euthanasia Parliamentary Debate Delayed** A further delay to the introduction of a bill means that it is unlikely to enter the Legislative Assembly (lower house) before Tuesday 5 September. Debate would then be delayed by another two weeks to 19 September. This means we have another three weeks to write letters. Monday 11 September would now be the latest day that these letters can be sent and still arrive in MPs office before the debate.

This weekend the second collection will be sent to the Asylum Seeker Resource Centre which has set up an emergency appeal. There will be further collections later in September. Next weekend will be reserved for the annual appeal for Retired Priests.
