#### **WORLD DAY OF THE POOR**

This poor man cried, and the Lord heard him 2018

Sunday 18th November is the second World Day of the Poor. Pope Francis calls on all Christians to combat indifference to the suffering and marginalisation of the most needy. Indifference to others results in our diminished joy, participation and responsibility. We're better together when we care for the dignity of each other. Pope Francis writes in his World Day of the Poor message: "For the poor to overcome their oppressive situation, they need to sense the presence of brothers and sisters who are concerned for them and, by opening the doors of their hearts and lives, make them feel like friends and family. Only in this way can the poor discover 'the saving power at work in their lives' and 'put them at the centre of the Church's pilgrim way' (Evangelii Gaudium, 198). I would like this year's, and all future World Days, to be celebrated in a spirit of joy at the rediscovery of our capacity for togetherness". Highlighting awareness of the plight of the poor on this Sunday, medical assistance will be offered in a tent hospital in St Peter's Square. Meanwhile the Pope will host lunch for 3000 people who are in need witnessing his message that we the Church are to be a field hospital for all offering

welcome, healing and accompaniment.


