## Two Canonisations Today!

(14<sup>th</sup> October)

- 1) **Pope Paul VI** – who insisted on the final document from Vatican II - The Church in the modern world TODAY. He realised the spirit of the council needed continual updating – “The joys, hopes, griefs and anxieties of the men (sic) of this age, especially those who are poor or in any way afflicted, these too are the joys and hopes, the griefs and anxieties of the followers of Christ”, is the very famous beginning of this document that keeps Vatican II alive today.



- 2) **Oscar Romero** – much loved and honoured as a saint from even before his martyrdom. Romero – Archbishop from 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 1977 to his assassination on 24<sup>th</sup> March, 1980. A man who expected to be murdered because he fiercely disturbed the powerful and he knew that God would raise up others to speak. It took a long time for the official Church to recognise his sainthood, partly because he was assassinated by fellow Christians.

Let us honour these 2 great prophets.
