JOB DESCRIPTION - Group Leader

The Group Leader will engage young people in a safe and social environment at our Catholic Church of **St Kevin's Parish, Templestowe** by supporting the existing Youth Ministry. The successful applicant will be required to lead and conduct regular youth group events for the youth of our Parish aged between 10-13 years of age.

Please note: the term 'Youth Group' within this role refers to a **social** group for the youth of the Parish. Our commitment to our Parish children is to provide a supportive, inclusive environment that is social, engaging and reflects the Parish's values and faith.

The position is an on-going casual role beginning January 2019 working 10 to 12hrs per month inclusive of 3 hours obligatory third Saturday monthly event evening and a fortnightly meeting with the Parish Youth Ministry team.

Duties

- Actively lead and engage each Youth Group event.
- Support the Youth Ministry, of St Kevin's Parish and its' program for the youth.
- Develop and create (under the guidance of the Youth Ministry) activities for the existing 'TGI's youth group' events.
- Promote Youth Group through active communication (email, flyers, etc)
- Provide feedback on the running of and after each youth group session
- Identify volunteers to assist in the running of the youth group
- Arranging additional formation opportunities for the benefit of the Youth Ministry

- Experience in working with children
- Experience in leading youth groups including developing and running programs for them
- Ability to encourage social participation and adaptable to a variety of needs
- Enthusiastic and ability to work autonomously
- An appreciation of and regard for Christian/Catholic values

- Life skills and/or educational qualifications (completed or in progress), in youth ministry/work or similar experience a bonus
