Building Renovations –



The community of St. Joseph's Parish, Northcote was established in 1893 - 128 years ago. We take pride in our long and rich history and embrace our traditions, our faith and love for God. This is a place where many of our parishioners were born and grew up. History shows that St Joseph's Northcote has a rich heritage, not only in its material value, but also by the witness we have of what previous generations have passed down to us.

Father Shabin, liaising with the Finance and Leadership Committees, has agreed to proceed with the St Joseph's church repair. The repair will comprise cleaning, sealing and making the church building safe. Father Shabin and committee members are in the process of assessing quotes for the works. Pending engineering reports, the arches will be made safe, with the aim of removing the altar barriers. The current rustic character of the church will remain.

Funds will be required to finance this project. The generosity of parishioners and friends will be relied upon.

Furthermore, it has been agreed by the afore-mentioned, the presbytery, excluding the office, kitchen and money-counting room, will be leased to help offset the cost of the church repair and ongoing maintenance issues. Father Shabin is collaborating with the archdiocese with this initiative. The Finance and Maintenance Committee next meets on Tuesday, 13 July 2021 to address issues of methods and strategies regarding commencing the repair and fundraising.

Parishioners are welcome to put forward their ideas on how St Joseph's moves forward.

Every year, Catholics come together across Australia to acknowledge and celebrate the gifts of Australia's First Peoples in the Catholic Church. This year, the National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Catholic Council (NATSICC) have adopted the NAIDOC theme for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday (4)

July): "Heal Country".

In Laudato Si', Pope Francis called us to continue to seek greater protections for our lands, our waters, our sacred sites and our cultural heritage from exploitation, desecration, and destruction. This year is particularly important following the COVID 19 Pandemic and its impact on the ways in which we interacted and made contact with one another.

NATSICC reminds us that while Christianity in Australia goes back more than 200 years, the Spirit of God was poured out onto the original inhabitants of this great Southern Land many, many thousands of years prior. God's Spirit could be heard through the singing of the birds, the cascade of the waterfall, the rustle of the wind and, most importantly, in silence.

Dr Miriam-Rose Ungunmerr-Baumann AM, a respected Ngangiwumirr Elder, educator, artist and 2021 Senior Australian of the Year, explains the importance of listening and understanding the silence:

'My people today, recognise and experience in this quietness, the great Life-Giving Spirit, the Father of us all. It is easy for me to experience God's presence. When I am out hunting, when I am in the bush, among the trees, on a hill or by a billabong; these are the times when I can simply be in God's presence. My people have been so aware of Nature. It is natural that we will feel close to the Creator.'
