

Dear Parishioners and Visitors.

The daunting complexity of modern life colours and challenges the way people experience the coming of God into their human experience. This season of Advent and Christmas soon to follow, evokes for most of us special memories, yet for some people, the Christmas season triggers extremely painful memories. It may be the loneliness after the death of a loved one, or the pain of a broken relationship. However, I believe even with those scenarios, there is the possibility of choosing grateful memories over the painful kind. Many youngsters remember the days approaching Christmas as filled with youthful enthusiasm, joy and great expectations. It usually means 'waiting' for that special day and 'getting' wonderful things. But some adults, long after childhood, might also remember a special insight which called them to a different kind of Christmas. Why not do something different and reach out to someone, the neighbour, the stranger or the homeless in sincere service and respect. Yes, we can easily get side tracked by the traditional cultural attachments of Christmas which cling and clutter like tinsel and glitter. We may need to search for deeper reasons why the birth of Jesus fascinates us. Even the word 'birth' suggests such a powerful mystery. The wonder of birth spans the whole spectrum of life. Human birth creates an instant parental relationship as well as an undeniable bond with an extended family. Even St. Joseph responds to the independence of the child Jesus, by standing with and for Mary and her newborn son as loving, faithful protector. May we, this Advent, sense the presence of the Son through not only the little ones around us but that 'new life' in all its forms, is just around the corner for all of us.

I feel confident it will be another great weekend for the Parish as we celebrate 'the new Preps' Mass' and the Parish barbeque immediately afterwards. Thank you to all who have been involved and those special people from the Parish Council who have co-ordinated the Parish barbeque.

As soon as singer/song writer Peter Kearney announced that he was coming down from Sydney and that he would be available for a Lenten concert-reflection in early April next year in the parishes of Melbourne, I made sure to get in touch with him.
