Our friendly volunteers are happy to assist with any enquiries and can help locate your favourite author or direct you to books on your favourite subject The Bookshop is currently open from 10am to 1pm Monday to Saturday but will resume normal hours on Monday 29th November. It will then operate from 10am to 4pm Monday to Friday and 10am to 1pm on Saturdays. It will close on 22nd December and reopen January 2022. "And this is my prayer: that your love may increase ever more and more in knowledge and every kind of what perception, to discern is of value..." Supporting the Parish

Through the Stewardship Program, parishioners are asked to pledge a weekly/monthly amount to the upkeep of the parish. This allows the parish to pay utility bills, insurance premiums, Archdiocese levies, purchase church supplies and pay staff wages. This amount is given as the "Thanksgiving Offering" and placed in the appropriate envelope or given as a direct debit.

The 'Presbytery Offering' along with any loose cash contributes to the support of the Parish Priest. A percentage of the Presbytery collection is also required to be sent quarterly to the Archdiocese.
