A welcome return to Mass "Book early, come early, bring proof!"

The following will assist to prepare for your Mass attendance:

- Proof of full Vaccination status is required.
- Booking to attend each Mass will be essential. Bring your booking confirmation.
- The 5pm Sunday Mass at Mitcham will be available for parishioners not fully vaccinated.
- QR code check-in using the Services Victoria app will continue to be a requirement.
- Mass attendance numbers will be within prescribed density requirements. Booking is essential. See the Parish website for details.

Please arrive 5 or 10 minutes earlier than you normally would.

When you arrive:

- Enter via the Narthex
- Show your booking confirmation
- See a Check-in-Marshal: provide proof of full vaccination and QR code your attendance
- Sanitise prior to entering
- Mask wearing is mandatory
- Practice Social distancing

A recorded Mass will continue to be available from Sunday evening. See the parish website.

Fellow Parishioners will be volunteering as Covid Marshals and Covid Check-in Marshals at all our weekend Masses for the foreseeable future. Please assist them as much as you can to undertake their important public health role. Your patience and understanding as we implement these requirements will be appreciated.

"And 'to love him with all your heart, with all your understanding, with all your strength, and to love your neighbour as yourself' is worth more than all the burnt offerings and sacrifices." (Mark 12:33)

Of all the gifts that God gives us, the one He wants the most is our heart. He wants us to share out of our love for Him, not out of obligation. Using our talent in parish ministry and contributing money to support our parish mission is important, but it's more important to spend time in prayer with God daily and discern how He is calling us to be generous with all of our gifts. Not just the visible ones, but the invisible ones like love, mercy and forgiveness.

Supporting the Parish

Through the Stewardship Program, parishioners are asked to pledge a weekly/monthly amount to the upkeep of the parish. This allows the parish to pay utility bills, insurance premiums, Archdiocese levies, purchase church supplies and pay staff wages. This amount is given as the "Thanksgiving Offering" and placed in the appropriate envelope or given as a direct debit.

The 'Presbytery Offering' along with any loose cash contributes to the support of the Parish Priest. A percentage of the Presbytery collection is also required to be sent quarterly to the Archdiocese.
