A welcome return to Mass from this weekend 7th Nov "Book early, come early, bring proof!"

The following will assist to prepare for your Mass attendance:

- Proof of full Vaccination status is required.
- Booking to attend each Mass will be essential. Bring your booking confirmation.
- The 5pm Sunday Mass will be available for parishioners not fully vaccinated.
- QR code check-in using the Services Victoria app will continue to be a requirement.
- Mass attendance numbers will be within prescribed density requirements. Booking is essential. See the Parish website for details

Please arrive 5 or 10 minutes earlier than you normally would.

When you arrive:

- Enter via the Narthex
- Show your booking confirmation
- See a Check-in-Marshal: provide proof of full vaccination and QR code your attendance
- Sanitise prior to entering
- Mask wearing is mandatory
- Practice Social distancing
