Our slow steps to attending Mass

Dear Parishioners

As we come out of the current restrictions a number of requirements need to be followed:

1. Proof of Vaccination status will be important for any Mass attendance.
2. Booking to attend Mass will be essential for the foreseeable future.
3. QR code check-in using the Services Victoria app will continue to be a requirement.

Mass attendance numbers will need to be within prescribed density requirements.

A recorded Parish weekend Mass will continue to be available via the Mitcham Parish website for the foreseeable future.
