The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference has decided to have a Plenary Council for the Church in Australia in 2020. A Plenary Council is the highest formal gathering of all local churches in a country. The last one held in Australia was in 1937.

In October 2020 the first Plenary Council session will be held. This will be followed by a second in 2021 where voting on proposals will take place. These proposals will have come from the discerning that will have taken place next year. What is being discerned in 2019 will come from local listening and dialogue sessions that will occur during this year up until Ash Wednesday next year. The local listening and dialogue sessions have been asked to respond to the question, "What do you think God is asking of us in Australia at this time?"

We hope to have dialogue and listening session in our parish in the not too distant future. Through our parish newsletter we will keep you informed of details about upcoming sessions.
