THE FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, the Easter season is over with Pentecost, which we celebrated last Sunday. Today we are back again to the remaining

long period of Ordinary Season, to begin it with the solemn celebration of the feast of "The Most Holy Trinity."

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life. God alone can make it known to us by revealing Himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Today, when we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity, let us praise & glorify

the Triune God and bring ourselves in the peace and joy of living in communion with the Divine life of the Father, the Son & Samp; the Holy Spirit, which is actually the model of our Christian life & our Christian families.

Singing "Down in Adoration Falling" and incensing will follow. A Blessing with the Blessed Sacrament and reciting the Divine Praises and the Blessed Sacrament will then be return to the tabernacle. The final hymn will then be sung.


SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION


