## REFLECTION

#### ASCENSION – the absence of the present one!

The Ascension occurred in the life of Jesus when after his resurrection He moved from his face-to-face presence with those early disciples. 'What now?' those disciples could be thinking as He left them with his command to go out to all the world and be like him and spread the gospel. How could they do it without Him? His ascending is a loss for them, it could seem - for He is absent, or so it seems.

Like those disciples after the Ascension, we can have times of wondering why God seems to have disappeared. At times we can struggle finding Git can be a struggle to find God in today's church and world, where violence, war, pandemics, natural disasters, scandals, abuse of power feature so boldly.

How then, can we be open to the emerging 'new' that Jesus promised when he said: "It is better for you that I go away! You will be sad now, but your sadness will turn to joy. If I don't go away, you will be unable to receive my Spirit. Don't cling to me, I must ascend." (Jn 16:7,8) and 'lifting up his hands, he blessed them'. (Lk 24:50)?

The ascension of Jesus into heaven is not only about absence. Pope Francis has it this way: "it tells us that He is living among us in a new way". After all, Jesus did promise to be with us always and that 'the Spirit of truth... You know him, because he abides with you and will be in you' (In 15:17) will be amongst us.

What is this new way? How is Jesus blessing us now? What gifts of the Holy Spirit are you noticing in your own life and

All of us need Pentecost to gift us with a new spirit and blessings to live the life we are living now, even as we may wish it were different from what it is. What do we need to let go of? Where are the signs of new life emerging for us? Spirit, come transform us!
