ADVENT AGAIN?

The great Advent figure John the Baptist wants us to join his crusade for 'straighter ways' in life and for a more just world; he alerts us to a Saviour who asks for our participation in His magnificent enterprise of 'giving life to all'. He urges us in today's Advent Word to play our role by living renewed, hopeful lives that add to the quality of life and goodness in the world.

Advent is a waiting for someone we know is here already! We recall in Advent that the Lord Jesus has come among us, is present all the time, and whose 'kingdom' will be fulfilled (as 'he comes again').

He is the child who is born anew, as it were, each year: for the world always needs its God and saviour. He is the life of God who is born anew, as it were, each year: for the world needs its God and Saviour. Our lives are different each year as we get older and come through new experiences. We need him in different ways at different stages of life.

And the world has different needs of God at different times.

We need 'the child of peace' to be born again in our wars and violence,

the 'child of wisdom' in our search for truth and meaning, the 'child of gentleness' in a world which can be harsh and greedy. We need to know that in the birth of Jesus each year there is the everlasting promise of God to be with us.

Advent looks ahead, too, letting us see that the life of Jesus is never over, that the truth of Jesus is always spoken again and again, and that he will one day be seen in glory.

For we are people not only of Advent but also of Easter, of waiting and of resurrection.

We are people of earth and Heaven as he is the Son of Mary and the Son of God,

who leads us through our life on earth to the eternal glory of Heaven.

PARISH UPDATE

COVID-SAFE RESTRICTIONS HAVE BEEN EASED

COVID restrictions now allow our churches to be open for Mass, "with no capacity limits or density limits", everyone to be "fully vaccinated". Bookings are no longer required.

As well, there is an extra Mass with those of 'unknown vaccination status', limited to 50 participants, at Sacred Heart at 6.30pm on Saturdays. Bookings are required at https://www.trybooking.com/BMKXC

Everyone is to record their presence (by QR or manually).

"Masks are required indoors only in limited settings". Our churches are not listed as a 'limited setting'.
