- **1.** <u>Baptisms</u> are held on the First and Third Sundays of the month at 11.30am. Please contact the parish office for details of Baptisms scheduled over the Summer Holiday period.
- 2. A <u>Baptismal Preparation Meeting</u> must be attended by Parents and Godparents before the Baptism.

These meetings are normally held on the fourth Sunday of each month at St Bernard's in the Parish Centre (Hall) at 11.15am.

- **3.** <u>Registration Forms</u> can be downloaded from our website: *pol.org.au/bacchusmarsh*. Please bring completed forms and a copy of the child's Birth Certificate to the preparation meeting on Sunday morning.
- 4. Families are required to attend a <u>Welcome Mass</u> so that the child or children being Baptised can be presented to the Community. You can come to any Sunday mass before the baptism. Please make yourself known to the priest before mass begins, and then sit near the front of Church so you can be called forward after the homily.
- 5. <u>Godparents</u> assist parents in sharing their faith with their children. They witness to the love of Christ, encourage their Godchildren to live a life of holiness and make the Catholic faith their own during their life.

The requirements for Godparents are:

- 1. At least one Godparent must be Catholic.
- 2. If you choose two Godparents, one must be male and one female
- **3.** You only need one Godparent. However, if you cannot find a suitable second Catholic Godparent, you may choose a Christian witness as the second person. They must be a baptised Christian (eg Anglican, Uniting, Baptist) but do not need to be Catholic.
