



### Do not be afraid

Last Sunday we heard Jesus calling and commissioning disciples to take on his own ministry of spreading the Good News of God's reign: today this episode continues as Jesus





What encouragement would he offer us today, living here in Australia? What would Australian Christians have to be afraid of? Would living out your faith ever place you at risk? Perhaps not of being killed, but of being thought odd, old-fashioned and a bit ridiculous! How would Christian values be listened to around your lunch table at work? What do you think of Christians who get involved in justice issues—not just theoretically, but by acting and doing something? How are such people presented in the media? Living Christianity can still be a health hazard in a society that lives out values of secularism and materialism.

Jesus then continues—'Declare yourself.' Where do you stand? For the reign of God or against it? Would anyone even know you are a Christian? What are **you** afraid of?

### First Reading: Jer 20:10-13

Jeremiah said:

'I hear so many disparaging me, "Terror from every side!

Denounce him! Let us denounce him!"

All those who used to be my friends watched for my downfall,

"Perhaps he will be seduced into error.

Then we will master him and take our revenge!"

But the Lord is at my side, a mighty hero;

my opponents will stumble, mastered,

confounded by their failure;

everlasting, unforgettable disgrace will be theirs.

But you, Lord of Hosts, you who probe with justice,

who scrutinise the loins and heart, let me see the vengeance you will take on them,

for I have committed my cause to you.

Sing to the Lord, praise the Lord, for he has delivered the soul of the needy

from the hands of evil men.'

### Second Reading: Rom 5:12-15

Sin entered the world through one man, and through sin death, and thus death has spread through the whole human race because everyone has sinned. Sin existed in the world long before the Law was given. There was no law and so no one could be accused of the sin of 'law-breaking', yet death reigned over all from Adam to Moses, even though their sin, unlike that of Adam, was not a matter of breaking a law.

Adam prefigured the One to come, but the gift itself considerably outweighed the fall. If it is certain that through one man's fall so many died, it is even more certain that divine grace, coming through the one man, Jesus Christ, came to so many as an abundant free gift.

### Gospel Mt 10:26-33

Jesus instructed the Twelve as follows: 'Do not be afraid. For everything that is now covered will be uncovered, and everything now hidden will be made clear. What I say to you in the dark, tell in the daylight; what you hear in whispers, proclaim from the house-tops.

'Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; fear him rather who can destroy both body and soul in hell. Can you not buy two sparrows for a penny? And yet not one falls to the ground without your Father knowing. Why, every hair on your head has been counted. So there is no need to be afraid; you are worth more than hundreds of sparrows.

'So if anyone declares himself for me in the presence of men, I will declare myself for him in the presence of my Father in heaven. But the one who disowns me in the presence of men, I will disown in the presence of my Father in heaven.'


