In my reading this week I came across the following which I thought appropriate as we continue to struggle with COVID.

“Christian Hope. What do we hope for in this strange time of lockdown? Hope is a strange Christian attitude, but incredibly important. It places us between the now and the not-yet. Can you remember all the way back to Pre-Virus, when we had never heard of Corona (or Zoom, for that matter)? Do you recall how simple things were then, in contrast to this extraordinary moment when it is suddenly no longer possible to plan, and all we can do is live one day at a time? So “hope” is what gets us through the darkness; and it is not the same as being “optimistic”. Our source of hope is not the gloomy insight that “things” can’t possibly get any worse; so they must get better.” Rather it is the entirely cheerful certainty that God has raised Jesus from the dead, so everything is all right, no matter how dark things may appear.”

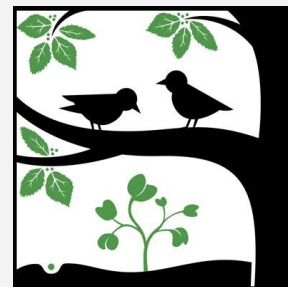

SCORESBY 2021—PARISH RENEWAL PROGRAM PAUSE DUE TO LOCKDOWN

Parish Renewal Program Faith—Engagement—Commitment



As a result of the extended lockdown announced by Acting Premier, James Merlino, we have taken the decision to **extend the planned pause on our Parish Renewal Program.**

Given the uncertainty surrounding the length of the lockdown period and the likelihood of limitations on Mass sizes when we emerge, we believe it a prudent measure to **defer the completion of the Renewal Program until August.** This will enable us to complete the 4 weeks period of First Eucharist celebrations in July and some 'clear air' to focus on this important Parish Program. The exact dates for the final 2 weeks of the Renewal Program will be confirmed in coming weeks and notified to all parishioners through the Parish Newsletter, on our website and via emails and SMS.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK & THE SIGNING OF THE SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE CODE OF CONDUCT ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS AT ST JUDE’S PARISH SCORESBY



For St Jude’s Parish to be compliant with the Safeguarding requirements **all volunteers over the age of 18 years** are required to have a current **Working with Children Check** which can be accessed by visiting www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au and follow the prompts. Under the field “Child-Related Work, choose “64-Religious Organisation”. It is imperative that all volunteers have this check in place. In the instance that you are a registered teacher with the VIT and although you are not required to have a WWCC it is necessary to notify Working with Children Check Victoria that you volunteer at St Jude’s Parish.

Another requirement is to read the “**Safeguarding Children & Young People Code of Conduct Declaration**”, sign and return the ‘**Code of Conduct**’ to the parish office at your earliest convenience.

Copies can be found at the exit points of the Church or by phoning the Parish Office. Could you please write on the document the name(s) of the group(s) you participate in, for example, reader/cleaner etc. by doing so this will make it easier to categorise the parish groups and ensure our parish data base is accurate.

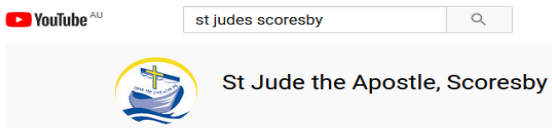
On arrival, you will still need to check-in using you phone and the **Victorian Government QR code** and also have your name checked off the Trybooking list.

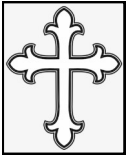
