Embracing Mission with Love and Trust

Your TURN: *Know you are sent to bring healing* —Mark 6:7-13



Mark 6:7-13 shows Jesus sending out the apostles to preach and heal, emphasising reliance on God's provision and the hospitality of others.

Mission of Love —Jesus sends the apostles to share the message for God's love, aiming to bring healing and hope.

Trust and Simplicity—By taking nothing for their journey, the apostles demonstrate trust in God's provision and in the goodness of people.

Hospitality—Welcoming others and accepting hospitality are expressions of mutual love and kindness.

Handling Rejection—Shaking off dust from their feet shows respect for others' freedom and a loving response to rejection without resentment.

Healing—Acts of healing and deliverance by the apostles are profound expressions of love and compassion.

This passage underscores that love is central to the Christian mission, requiring trust, hospitality, respect, and compassion.

Loving God, help us to trust in your provision, extend hospitality to others, and respond with compassion and grace. Guide us to share Your message of love through our words and actions. Amen

Important Reminder for Volunteers

We remind you of the importance of maintaining a current Working With Children Check (WWCC). It is imperative that all volunteers ensure their WWCC is up-to-date. **This is not only a requirement set forth by our Archdiocese but also a legal obligation.** Adherence to these guidelines is essential to maintain a safe and supportive environment for everyone in our community. As you are aware the **WWCC is not solely for those working with children, it also encompasses the protection of vulnerable adults.** As such, it is crucial for all volunteers, regardless of their specific role, to have a valid and current check.

We kindly ask you to review the status of your WWCC and renew it if necessary by **the end of July**. If you need assistance or have any questions regarding this process, please do not hesitate to contact the parish office on 9763 7302.

First Reading: Amos 7:12-15

Amaziah, the priest of Bethel, said to Amos, 'Go away, seer; get back to the land of Judah; earn your bread there, do your prophesying there. We want no more prophesying in Bethel; this is the royal sanctuary, the national temple.' 'I was no prophet, neither did I belong to any of the brotherhoods of prophets.' Amos replied to Amaziah, 'I was a shepherd, and looked after sycamores: but it was the Lord who took me from herding the flock, and the Lord who said, "Go, prophesy to my people Israel."

Second Reading: Ephesians 1:3-10

Blessed be God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with all the spiritual blessings of heaven in Christ.

Before the world was made, he chose us, chose us in Christ, to be holy and spotless, and to live through love in his presence, determined that we should become his adopted sons, through Jesus Christ for his own kind purposes, to make us praise the glory of his grace, his free gift to us in the Beloved in whom, through his blood, we gain our freedom, the forgiveness of our sins. Such is the richness of the grace which he has showered on us in all wisdom and insight. He has let us know the mystery of his purpose, the hidden plan he so kindly made in Christ from the beginning to act upon when the times had run their course to the end: that he would bring everything together under Christ, as head, everything in the heavens and everything on earth.

Gospel: Mark 6:7-13

Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out in pairs giving them authority over the unclean spirits. And he instructed them to take nothing for the journey except a staff – no bread, no haversack, no coppers for their purses. They were to wear sandals, but, he added, 'Do not take a spare tunic.' And he said to them, 'If you enter a house anywhere, stay there until you leave the district. And if any place does not welcome you and people refuse to listen to you, as you walk away shake off the dust from under your feet as a sign to them.' So they set off to preach repentance; and they cast out many devils, and anointed many sick people with oil and cured them.
