Dear Friends

Shortly we will begin to ease our way out of this Lockdown which began on August 4th!! We have all faced many, many challenges during these last two and a half months and as we gently move on there will still be challenges to face. Some of those will be to do with our participation in parish life, especially Sunday (Saturday pm) Mass. As Parish Priest I have a duty of care for all, a duty in which we all share. And the advice is very, very clear. Vaccination is the way back to the life we long for, and that includes Mass. Pope Francis has said he believes 'that morally everyone must take the vaccine...it is the moral choice because it is about your life but also the lives of others'. He has described taking the vaccine as 'act of love". So I ask that all take on board the decisions that have been made and will be made as we go forward. There is no escaping the fact unfortunately that things will be messy for a while. I ask for your understanding and patience. For instance arrival at mass, using the QR code and displaying your vaccination details will be tedious but necessary. Both of these are a requirement of the Chief Health Officer for people entering venues and Churches are venues. So for a while we need to be a little 'unCatholic' and turn up 20 minutes early!!

First Reading—Isaiah 53:10-11

The Lord has been pleased to crush his servant with suffering. If he offers his life in atonement, he shall see his heirs, he shall have a long life and through him what the Lord wishes will be done.

His soul's anguish over he shall see the light and be content. By his sufferings shall my servant justify many, taking their faults on himself.

Second Reading—Hebrews :14-16

Since in Jesus, the Son of God, we have the supreme high priest who has gone through to the highest heaven, we must never let go of the faith that we have professed. For it is not as if we had a high priest who was incapable of feeling our weaknesses with us; but we have one who has been tempted in every way that we are, though he is without sin. Let us be confident, then, in approaching the throne of grace, that we shall have mercy from him and find grace when we are in need of help.

Gospel —Mark 10:35-4

James and John, the sons of Zebedee, approached Jesus. 'Master,' they said to him, 'we want you to do us a favour.' He said to them, 'What is it you want me to do for you?' They said to him, 'Allow us to sit one at your right hand and the other at your left in your glory.' 'You do not know what you are asking' Jesus said to them. 'Can you drink the cup that I must drink, or be baptised with the baptism with which I must be baptised?' They replied, 'We can.' Jesus said to them, 'The cup that I must drink you shall drink, and with the baptism with which I must be baptised you shall be baptised, but as for seats at my right hand or my left, these are not mine to grant; they belong to those to whom they have been allotted.'

When the other ten heard this they began to feel indignant with James and John, so Jesus called them to him and said to them: 'You know that among the pagans their so-called rulers lord it over them, and their great men make their authority felt. This is not to happen among you. No; anyone who wants to become great among you must be your servant, and anyone who wants to be first among you must be slave to all. For the Son of Man himself did not come to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.'



St. Judes' Roadmap for Return to Masses

The Parish Pastoral Council are processing the relevant information from the recent roadmap announced by the State Government. As the rules are complex and timelines subject to vaccination rates, we ask for your patience as we work out a plan for our return to Masses in the church.

All Volunteers—As a result of advice from the Chief Health Officer to all parishes that all "religious workers in our Parishes", which include paid parish staff, all volunteers including readers, ministers of Eucharist, ministers to the sick, collectors, laptop operators, children's liturgy, musicians etc., are subject to Mandatory Vaccination (Workers) Directions.

To help assist the parish office to start the process we are asking that you provide a copy of your **fully vaccinated certificate** either by email or use the parish office chute to confirm your double vaccination status. If you could attend to this at your earliest convenience this will help to reduce the additional administrative duties that are required for when we are permitted to celebrate masses.

Thank you for your cooperation and ensuring that our parish community remains safe.

No one should have to skip a meal to pay their heating bill or because they can't afford to buy food, but we know that is happening in Victoria today especially during this challenging



extensive LOCKDOWN period. People in our community call our Assistance Welfare line every day of the week asking for groceries. We believe that shouldn't be happening, and this is what we do about it.
