# A Call to Prayer

This week the population of the entire city of Lisbon, Portugal is expected to double, as hundreds of thousands of predominately young Catholics from every continent on earth descend upon the city. The final open-air mass, presided over by Pope Francis, is expected to draw a crowd of over 1 million people.



A month ago, the organising committee released some statistics:

- The WYD Lisbon 2023 Foundation has hired the supply of almost 3 million meals
- Over **22,000 volunteers** from 143 countries will help out
- 10,000 vestments are being produced for the priests and bishops for masses
- 7,138 families are opening their homes to host young pilgrims, with 472,926 individual overnight accommodation places being made available across the city
- Over 1800kg of wheat for the manufacture of Communion hosts, which are being produced by the Clarisse Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary Monastery in Lisbon

From Melbourne, about 600 young Catholics, teachers and priests will join about 3000 fellow Australians. In short, it's a big deal! So, this week, I'm asking you to pray for the success of this epic event. Pray, in the words of today's gospel, that our young people become 'disciples of the kingdom of heaven'; pray that they find the 'treasure' of God's love, 'hidden in the field' of this life's hopes and dreams, grief's and anxieties; pray that like the merchant, their seeking will be rewarded in finding the pearl of great price and that they give their lives to for it through the love of God and neighbour.

In the Christian life, very little is achieved without prayer. So pray for the pilgrims this week and know that we're praying for you!

#### Serve the Lord with Joy

### First Reading: 1 Kgs 3:5 7-12

The Lord appeared to Solomon in a dream and said, 'Ask what you would like me to give you.' Solomon replied, 'Lord, my God, you have made your servant king in succession to David my father. But I am a very young man, unskilled in leadership. Your servant finds himself in the midst of this people of yours that you have chosen, a people so many its numbers cannot be counted or reckoned. Give your servant a heart to understand how to discern between good and evil, for who could govern this people of yours that is so great?' It pleased the Lord that Solomon should have asked for this. 'Since you have asked for this' the Lord said 'and not asked for long life for yourself or riches or the lives of your enemies, but have asked for a discerning judgement for yourself, here and now I do what you ask. I give you a heart wise and shrewd as none before you has had and none will have after you.'

#### Second Reading: Rom 8:28-30

We know that by turning everything to their good God co-operates with all those who love him, with all those that he has called according to his purpose. They are the ones he chose specially long ago and intended to become true images of his Son, so that his Son might be the eldest of many brothers. He called those he intended for this; those he called he justified, and with those he justified he shared his glory.

#### Gospel Mt 13:44-52

Jesus said to the crowds, 'The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field which someone has found; he hides it again, goes off happy, sells everything he owns and buys the field.

'Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls; when he finds one of great value he goes and sells everything he owns and buys it.

'Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a dragnet cast into the sea that brings in a haul of all kinds. When it is full, the fishermen haul it ashore; then, sitting down, they collect the good ones in a basket and throw away those that are no use. This is how it will be at the end of time: the angels will appear and separate the wicked from the just to throw them into the blazing furnace where there will be weeping and grinding of teeth.

'Have you understood all this?' They said, 'Yes.' And he said to them, 'Well, then, every scribe who becomes a disciple of the kingdom of heaven is like a householder who brings out from his storeroom things both new and old.'


