### A LITTLE COMPASSION AT LAST

I was relieved to see that the Federal Government has at last shown some compassion toward the Sri Lankan family from Biloela in Queensland. I know and appreciate that there is much emotion around the plight of asylum seekers and refugees. I often hear it said by commentators on radio that asylum seekers are 'illegal' which is not true as it is not an illegal act to seek asylum. The Australian Government has spent millions of dollars in the re-opening of Christmas Island Detention Centre where the family were housed. They were the only ones in detention with a staff at times of 125! This whole saga really has a touch of the bizarre about it. As John Menadue, the former Secretary of the Department of Immigration said during the week "There are options to resolve this matter with justice and fairness. Indeed the legislation is built around exceptions." And former Deputy Secretary of the Immigration Department, Abul Rizvi said in the press on Wednesday "...there are currently over 27,000 unsuccessful asylum seekers living in the Australian community and this number will rise significantly as more of the huge backlog of applications are processed. Legally these people are in the same position as the Biloela family but have not been removed from their community by Border Force as the Biloela family were." And it should be noted that these 27,000 people have come in the last 7 years. The only difference is that these 27,000 arrived by plane and not by boat, so they are not boat people!! Back on 2009 Pope Francis denounced what he called "the globalization of indifference" and said "a painful truth" is that "our world is daily more and more elitist, more cruel towards the excluded." I sometimes can't help but feel that this too often describes elements of policy and practice in this country.

### WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK & THE SIGNING OF THE SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE CODE OF CONDUCT ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS AT ST JUDE'S PARISH SCORESBY



For St Jude's Parish to be compliant with the Safeguarding requirements **all volunteers over the age of 18 years** are required to have a current **Working with Children Check** which can be accessed by visiting [www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au](http://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au) and follow the prompts. Under the field “Child-Related Work, choose “64-Religious Organisation”. It is imperative that all volunteers have this check in place. In the instance that you are a registered teacher with the VIT and although you are not required to have a WWCC it is necessary to notify Working with Children Check Victoria that you volunteer at St Jude's Parish.

Another requirement is to read the “**Safeguarding Children & Young People Code of Conduct Declaration**”, sign and return the ‘**Code of Conduct**’ to the parish office at your earliest convenience.

Copies can be found at the exit points of the Church or by phoning the Parish Office. Could you please write on the document the name(s) of the group(s) you participate in, for example, reader/cleaner etc. by doing so this will make it easier to categorise the parish groups and ensure our parish data base is accurate.

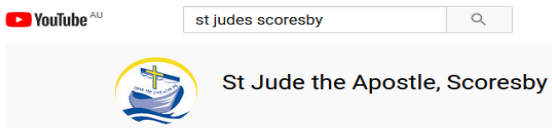
On arrival, you will still need to check-in using you phone and the **Victorian Government QR code** and also have your name checked off the Trybooking list.

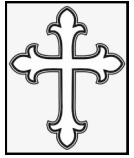
