



## EASTER SUNDAY

We welcome each one of you to this great celebration of Easter!


At Christmas we celebrated the absolutely amazing event of God becoming man and being born as a baby in a stable in first century Bethlehem!

Now, having been blown away by the loving gift expressed on Calvary – that Jesus, the Son of God, out of love for us should submit to the brutal death of a common criminal – we come to Easter Day to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus - and the new life which Jesus extends to all of us.

At Easter the world takes on a different tinge of colour – as along with Jesus we participate in our own 'resurrection'. Taken beyond the ordinary dimensions of our lives, we allow our spiritual selves to be lifted up in joy!

Each Sunday in the Mass we commemorate the Death and Resurrection of Jesus and open ourselves to the transforming love of Jesus.

If you would like to join us here each Sunday – as we pray for peace within ourselves and throughout the world – you will be most welcome.



#### 1st Reading -A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

Peter addressed Cornelius and his household: 'You must have heard about the recent happenings in Judaea; about Jesus of Nazareth and how he began in Galilee, after John had been preaching baptism. God had anointed him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and because God was with him, Jesus went about doing good and curing all who had fallen into the power of the devil. Now I, and those with me, can witness to everything he did throughout the countryside of Judaea and in Jerusalem itself: and also to the fact that they killed him by hanging him on a tree, yet three days afterwards God raised him to life and allowed him to be seen, not by the whole people but only by certain witnesses God had chosen beforehand.

Now we are those witnesses - we have eaten and drunk with him after his resurrection from the dead - and he has ordered us to proclaim this to his people and to tell them that God has appointed him to judge everyone, alive or dead. It is to him that all the prophets bear this witness: that all who believe in Jesus will have their sins forgiven through his name.'

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading a reading from the letter of St Paul to the Colossians

Since you have been brought back to true life with Christ, you must look for the things that are in heaven, where Christ is, sitting at God's right hand. Let your thoughts be on heavenly things, not on the things that are on the earth, because you have died, and now the life you have is hidden with Christ in God. But when Christ is revealed and he is your life – you too will be revealed in all your glory with him.

# Gospel - A reading from the Gospel according

It was very early on the first day of the week and still dark, when Mary of Magdala came to the tomb. She saw that the stone had been moved away from the tomb and came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved. 'They have taken the Lord out of the tomb' she said 'and we don't know where they have put him.'

Simon Peter who was following now came up, went right into the tomb, saw the linen cloths disciple who had reached the tomb first also went in; he saw and he believed. ### **Paschal Candle**


The design features the traditional elements of the Alpha, Omega and the year 2018, superimposed onto a beautiful Celtic Cross. The cross, with its circular background and endless knotwork, spirals and patterns, symbolises God's unending love for humankind and the salvation won for us through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The colours of the design are in rich tones of red, green, gold, yellow and blue, all of which proclaim the new life and joy of



The bands which surround the top and bottom of the candle also feature Celtic knot work and golden flames. The words on the bands echo the great proclamation from the Easter Vigil: "Christ Our Light" (top band) "Thanks Be to God (bottom band).


