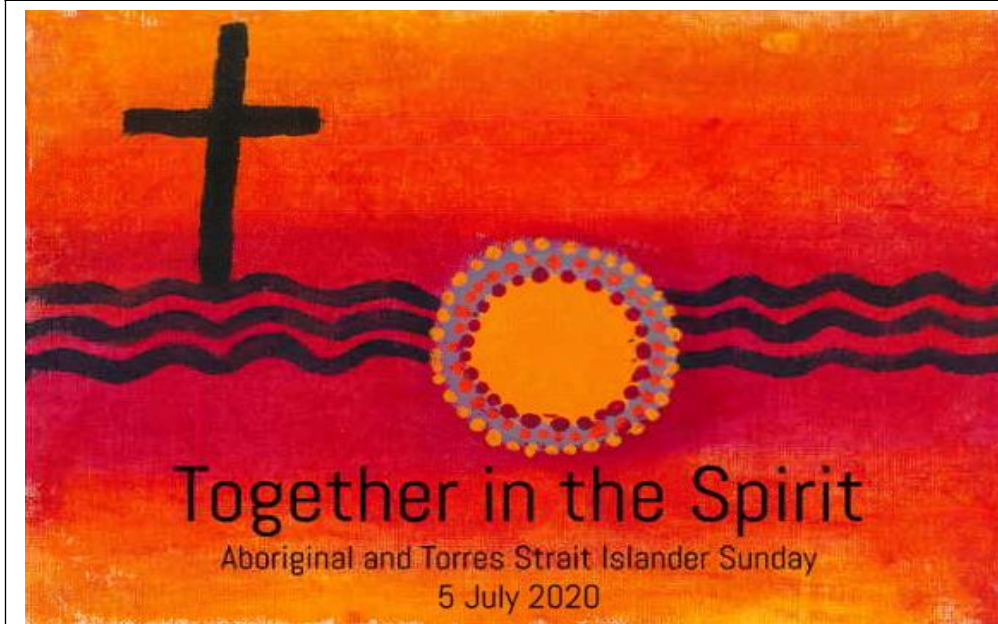

## Serve the Lord with Joy

### 1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Zechariah 9:9-10

The Lord says this: 'Rejoice heart and soul, daughter of Zion! Shout with gladness, daughter of Jerusalem! See now, your king comes to you; he is victorious, he is triumphant, humble and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey. He will banish chariots from Ephraim and horses from Jerusalem; the bow of war will be banished. He will proclaim peace for the nations. His empire shall stretch from sea to sea, from the River to the ends of the earth.'

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading – Romans 8:9.11-13

Your interests are not in the unspiritual, but in the spiritual, since the Spirit of God has made his home in you. In fact, unless you possessed the Spirit of Christ you would not belong to him, and if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, then he who raised Jesus from the dead will give life to your own mortal bodies through his Spirit living in you. So then, my brothers, there is no necessity for us to obey our unspiritual selves or to live unspiritual lives. If you do live in that way, you are doomed to die; but if by the Spirit you put an end to the misdeeds of the body you will live.

### Gospel – Matthew 11:25-30

Jesus exclaimed, 'I bless you, Father, Lord of heaven and of earth, for hiding these things from the learned and the clever and revealing them to mere children. Yes, Father, for that is what it pleased you to do. Everything has been entrusted to me by my Father; and no one knows the Son except the Father, just as no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him. 'Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened, and I will give you rest. Shoulder my yoke and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. Yes, my yoke is easy and my burden light.'

### REFLECTION by Dianne Bergant CSA

The readings for today engage us in a reflection on the nature of the Trinity, as well as the ways that we are enriched by each of the divine Persons. The gospel acknowledges the sovereignty of God. This is followed immediately by mention of the handing over of all things to Jesus, making him a kind of vice-regent of God. Paul speaks of the Spirit, clearly a divine reality, but different from Jesus and the one called God. According to Paul, this Spirit is the Spirit of Jesus and the Spirit of God, implying that somehow both Jesus and God claim the Spirit. It is this Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead, and it is this same Spirit who dwells in Christians. The grace of this Triune God touches our lives in some ways that are tangible and other ways that demand faith. The most tangible manifestation of God is Jesus himself. God has been revealed to us through this Jesus. While Jesus was a tangible person, our accepting of him as the manifestation of God requires faith, and this faith is no easier today than it was at the time of Jesus himself. The overriding disposition of these readings is humility. Jesus, the human manifestation of the divine, is meek and humble, and the true disciple is called to be humble. A second disposition is placed before us – grateful praise. In the psalm we praise and bless God; we extol God's holy name. In Jesus we have known the tender touch of God, and we are grateful.

### CONFIRMATION

Confirmation classes for our young people, who don't attend either St Jude's or Holy Trinity, will begin in early Term 3. The classes will be held as usual on Sunday morning over four consecutive Sundays. Whilst we don't as yet have a date on which we will be celebrating the sacrament, we thought it best to have our young people prepared. If you would like to have your child enrolled in these classes and you haven't yet done so, please contact the Parish Office as soon as possible.

### MASSES AT OUR PARISH

Fr Mark is delighted to welcome parishioners back to weekday and weekend Mass. **Our Mass times are as follows -**

- Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 9:15am
- Saturday 6:00pm
- Sunday 8:30am, 10:30am and 5:00pm.

As per Government Guidelines, Mass attendance is limited to 20 people (excluding those required to enable the service). All churches must comply with these restrictions, which include collecting contact details of those attending to assist with contact tracing if there is a risk of Coronavirus transmission. Therefore, all those who wish to attend Mass must register.

#### **How to register to attend Mass:**

1. Register using trybooking.com, <https://www.trybooking.com/BJXRT> – this is our preferred method, as you can register at any time. If you are unable to use trybooking.com, please register using one of the methods below.
2. Email [massrequest.stjudes@gmail.com](mailto:massrequest.stjudes@gmail.com) and provide your name, telephone number and Mass time that you wish to attend. Your email will be responded to within 24 hours with confirmation of your attendance.
3. Call the Parish Office during office hours (Tuesday to Thursday 9.15am to 2.45pm and Friday 9.15 to 12pm) to register, or leave a message outside office hours and we will return your call to confirm.

Only attend that Mass for which you have pre-registered and for which you have received confirmation. This will ensure that St Jude's comply with the restricted attendance and in fairness to other parishioners.

If you cannot attend the Mass you pre-registered for, please cancel your booking (either directly in trybooking.com or send an email to [massrequest.stjudes@gmail.com](mailto:massrequest.stjudes@gmail.com)) to enable another person to attend the Mass.

Please do not register for multiple Masses so that all parishioners have the opportunity to attend. **For weekend Masses, we suggest you attend one Mass per fortnight, until restrictions ease further.**
