# Serve the Lord with Joy

# 1st Reading - 2 Kings 4:8-11. 14-16

One day as Elisha was on his way to Shunem, a woman of rank who lived there pressed him to stay and eat there. After this he always broke his journey for a meal when he passed that way. She said to her husband, 'Look, I am sure the man who is constantly passing our way must be a holy man of God. Let us build him a small room on the roof, and put him a bed in it, and a table and chair and lamp; whenever he comes to us he can rest there.'

One day when he came, he retired to the upper room and lay down. 'What can be done for her?' he asked. Gehazi (his servant) answered, 'Well, she has no son and her husband is old.' Elisha said, 'Call her.' The servant called her and she stood at the door. 'This time next year,' Elisha said 'you will hold a son in your arms.'

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading - Romans 6:3-4. 8-11

When we were baptised in Christ Jesus we were baptised in his death; in other words, when we were baptised we went into the tomb with him and joined him in death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead by the Father's glory, we too might live a new life.

But we believe that having died with Christ we shall return to life with him: Christ, as we know, having been raised from the dead will never die again. Death has no power over him any more. When he died, he died, once for all, to sin, so his life now is life with God; and in that way, you too must consider yourselves to be dead to sin but alive for God in Christ Jesus.

# *Gospel - Matthew 10:37-42*

Jesus instructed the Twelve as follows: 'Anyone who prefers father or mother to me is not worthy of me. Anyone who prefers son or daughter to me is not worthy of me. Anyone who does not take his cross and follow in my footsteps is not worthy of me. Anyone who finds his life will lose it; anyone who loses his life for my sake will find it.

'Anyone who welcomes you welcomes me; and those who welcome me welcome the one who sent me. 'Anyone who welcomes a prophet because he is a prophet will have a prophet's reward; and anyone who welcomes a holy man because he is a holy man will have a holy man's reward.

'If anyone gives so much as a cup of cold water to one of these little ones because he is a disciple, then I tell you solemnly, he will most certainly not lose his reward.'

### **REFLECTION by Dianne Bergant CSA**

Today we are faced with the cost of discipleship, but we are also comforted by the promise of the providence of God. Baptism is for us both death and life. Through it we enter into Christ's death and we die to lives of selfishness and sin. Through it we rise with Christ to a new life freed from everything that previously held us down. As glorious as this new life might be, it requires death to our old ways of living, and this is always difficult.

The cost of discipleship cuts right to the core of our beings, it lays bare the very structures of kinship. Baptism recreates us as children of God; through it we are given a new life and born into a new family. The bonds of discipleship are now even stronger than the bonds of blood. Discipleship requires our very lives. As disciples we can no longer put ourselves first. We must be willing to spend ourselves and to be spent, to serve others in the day to day unfolding of life. We may find such commitment very demanding, but that is part of the cost of discipleship. God promises that if we lose our lives in this way, we will really gain them. If we are unselfish in the way we share ourselves with others, we will be enriched through our generosity. If we spend ourselves and are spent in our service of others we will be filled with blessings unimaginable.

### **CONFIRMATION**

Confirmation classes for our young people, who don't attend either St Jude's or Holy Trinity, will begin in early Term 3. The classes will be held as usual on Sunday morning over four consecutive Sundays. Whilst we don't as yet have a date on which we will be celebrating the sacrament, we thought it best to have our young people prepared. ### **MASSES AT OUR PARISH**

Fr Mark is delighted to welcome parishioners back to weekday and weekend Mass. **Our Mass times are as follows -**

Wednesday, Thursday and FridaySaturday9:15am6:00pm

• Sunday 8:30am, 10:30am and **5:00pm**.

As per Government Guidelines, Mass attendance is limited to 20 people (excluding those required to enable the service). All churches must comply with these restrictions, which include collecting contact details of those attending, to assist with contact tracing if there is a risk of Coronavirus transmission. Therefore, all those who wish to attend Mass must register.

## **How to register to attend Mass:**

- 1. Register using trybooking.com, <a href="https://www.trybooking.com/BJXRT">https://www.trybooking.com/BJXRT</a> this is our preferred method, as you can register at any time. If you are unable to use trybooking.com, please register using one of the methods below.
- 2. Email **massrequest.stjudes@gmail.com** and provide your name, telephone number and Mass time that you wish to attend. Your email will be responded to within 24 hours with confirmation of your attendance.
- 3. Call the Parish Office during office hours (Tuesday to Thursday 9.15 am to 2.45) pm to register, or leave a message outside office hours and we will return your call to confirm.


If registering by trybooking.com, registrations will remain open until 6 hours before weekend Mass, and 2pm the previous day for weekday Mass, unless the Mass is full.

If registering through one of the alternate methods, you must register at least 24 hours before the scheduled Mass time.

Only attend that Mass for which you have pre-registered and for which you have received confirmation. This will ensure that St Jude's comply with the restricted attendance and in fairness to other parishioners.

If you cannot attend the Mass you pre-registered for, please cancel your booking (either directly in trybooking.com or send an email to <a href="massrequest.stjudes@gmail.com">massrequest.stjudes@gmail.com</a>) to enable another person to attend the Mass.

Please do not register for multiple Masses so that all parishioners have the opportunity to attend. For weekend Masses, we suggest you attend one Mass per fortnight, until restrictions ease further.
