

#### SYNODALITY - WHAT'S THAT?

Synodality I suggest is a word we in the Catholic Church are going to hear a lot more of, certainly for the next twelve months or so and probably and hopefully much longer. Pope Paul VI established the Synod of



Essentially a synod means 'the same way' or 'the same path' and have occurred every two or three years for various reasons and have looked at topics such as The Family, The Word of God, The Middle East, Young People, The Amazon, The Eucharist. These synods have usually had a period of preparation followed by a short meeting in Rome of the delegate bishops with the Pope and then he produces a final document usually called an "apostolic exhortation."

However the next synod will be very different. Rather than addressing a specific topic this synod is really asking a question of all the baptised, not just the bishops and is really seeking to discover who we are called to be as Church in the midst of the reality of today's world. It is very much the initiative of Pope Francis who has said more than once we are now in "a change of era, not an era of change." We all struggle with change but when we think about it, it really is one of the constant things of life. And of course, the church is often not seen to be a place/ organisation/community that is about change. Many want to simply stay with what they know and with what they feel comfortable. Pope Francis is saying that won't work if we really are to be who we are called to be. Indeed our own renewal in the Archdiocese of Melbourne – 'Take the way of the Gospel' – is very much in line with what is happening throughout the whole Church and is certainly not unique to Melbourne. Essentially the key question for each of us is not what do I want but rather who do I/we need to be as a community of faith in service of the world today? It's a great question, challenging but with the potential to be so life giving.

# Gospel: Lk 16:19-31

Jesus said to the Pharisees: 'There was a rich man who used to dress in purple and fine linen and feast magnificently every day. And at his gate there lay a poor man called Lazarus, covered with sores, who longed to fill himself with the scraps that fell from the rich man's table. Dogs even came and licked his sores. Now the poor man died and was carried away by angels to the bosom of Abraham. The rich man also died and was buried.

'In his torment in Hades he looked up and saw Abraham a long way off with Lazarus in his bosom. So he cried out, "Father Abraham, pity me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am in agony in these flames." "My son," Abraham replied "remember that during your life good things come your way, just as bad things came the way of Lazarus. Now he is being comforted here while you are in agony. But that is not all: between us and you a great gulf has been fixed, to stop anyone, if he wanted to, crossing from our side to yours, and to stop any crossing from your side to ours."

'The rich man replied, "Father, I beg you then to send Lazarus to my father's house, since I have five brothers, to give them warning, so that they do not come to this place of torment too." "They have Moses and the prophets," said Abraham "let them listen to them." "Ah no, father Abraham," said the rich man "but if someone comes to them from the dead, they will repent." Then Abraham said to him, "If they will not listen either to Moses or to the prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone should rise from the dead."




