

1st Reading—Isaiah 50:4-7

The Lord has given me a disciple's tongue.

So that I may know how to reply to the wearied

he provides me with speech.

Each morning he wakes me to hear, to listen like a disciple.

The Lord has opened my ear.

For my part, I made no resistance, neither did I turn away. I offered my back to those who struck me, my cheeks to those who tore at my beard; I did not cover my face against insult and spittle.

The Lord comes to my help, so that I am untouched by the insults.

So. too. I set my face like flint: I know I shall not be shamed.

2nd Reading—Philippians 2:6-11

His state was divine, yet Christ Jesus did not cling to his equality with God but emptied himself to assume the condition of a slave, and became as men are, and being as all men are, he was humbler yet, even to accepting death, death on a cross. But God raised him high and gave him the name which is above all other names so that all beings in the heavens, on earth and in the underworld, should bend the knee at the name of Jesus and that every tongue should acclaim Jesus Christ as Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Gospel— John 12:12-16

A great crowd who had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. So, they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, crying, 'Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, the king of Israel!'

And Jesus found a young ass and sat upon it; as is written: 'Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your king is coming, sitting on an ass's colt!'

His disciples did not understand this at first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that this had been written of him and had been done to him.

- **Holy Thursday, Mass of the Lord's Supper**—1 April at **7.30pm** *There will be no washing of the feet.*
- Good Friday—Stations of the Cross— 2 April at 11am
 Good Friday—Commemoration of the Passion 2 April at 3pm
 There will be no physical contact during the Veneration of the Cross.
- Holy Saturday—3 April—No service
- Easter Sunday Vigil—Sunday 4th April at 5.30am followed by a Hot Cross Bun Breakfast Easter Sunday—Sunday 4th April at 8.30am & 10.30am
