THE SCANDAL THAT THE DJOKOVIC SAGA HAS REVEALED

This past week the media in its various forms have bombarded us with the visa circus around Novak Djokovic. In the midst of it all we heard that he had to contend with conditions in his quarantine location that were variously described as, 'unhealthy' 'appalling' 'inhumane' 'unacceptable' 'unsafe' 'risky' to name but a few. And no doubt there was much truth to the descriptions given. We also learnt that he had to deal with 'bed bugs', 'lack of adequate ventilation and fresh air', 'poor food', 'lack of exposure to sunlight', 'no access to exercise', but all of this only for a mere twenty-four hours or so. But the real scandal is that there are other occupants in the same building, refugees and asylum seekers, who have been experiencing the same conditions for years!! I'm left wondering what we as a nation have become? How is it that this supposedly Christian and lucky country can treat people in such a way? The Second Vatican Council, in one of the two main documents said: "The joys and hopes, the fears and anxieties of the people of our time, these too are the joy and hopes, the fears and anxieties of the followers of Christ, as nothing truly human fails to raise an echo in their hearts." Perhaps now we need to add a footnote that reads "except Australia." And in addition this week we hear of the continuing scandal of Afghanistan where it is now revealed that a million children are on the brink of malnutrition. Our walking away from the mess we helped create has contributed to this sad and tragic situation.
