This is very sad as at the end of the day the losers are the very ones that education is there for, namely students and as a flow on, the whole country is impacted when ideology takes over. For instance, there is a mindset, which sees education as not much more than something that contributes to the economy. Sadly these days, the 'economy' has become the be all and end all of life. So I was rather captured this week when I stumbled across the following from the wonderful Irish theologian, Sean McDonagh, who sadly died not long ago:

"I do not see the future of education as being robot-based. Education in the context of Jesus favours holistic education and not merely skills-based training programmes. All schools must attempt to create a learning environment where children are accepted as they are, and are encouraged to attain their full and unique potential as human beings, made in the image and likeness of God. Holistic education engages all aspects of the student's life. It is not focused merely on learning about ideas, but also encourages education in the arts, culture, science, languages, sport, ecology and religion. Schools that opt for holistic learning strive to encourage pupils to be unselfish and to use their gifts, not just to benefit themselves, but for the common good of other humans and the planet."

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK & THE SIGNING OF THE SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE CODE OF CONDUCT ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS AT ST JUDE'S PARISH SCORESBY



For St Jude's Parish to be compliant with the Safeguarding requirements **all volunteers over the age of 18 years** are required to have a current **Working with Children Check** which can be accessed by visiting www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au and follow the prompts. Under the field “Child-Related Work, choose “64-Religious Organisation”. It is imperative that all volunteers have this check in place. In the instance that you are a registered teacher with the VIT and although you are not required to have a WWCC it is necessary to notify Working with Children Check Victoria that you volunteer at St Jude's Parish.

Another requirement is to read the “**Safeguarding Children & Young People Code of Conduct Declaration**”, sign and return the ‘**Code of Conduct**’ to the parish office at your earliest convenience.

Copies can be found at the exit points of the Church or by phoning the Parish Office. Could you please write on the document the name(s) of the group(s) you participate in, for example, reader/cleaner etc. by doing so this will make it easier to categorise the parish groups and ensure our parish data base is accurate.

Important—Easing of Restrictions—Single QR Code Covid-19 Check-in System

As you aware parishioners are no longer required to pre-register for Mass via Trybooking. However, as you are aware it is **mandatory** for everyone to register arrival to Mass by using the single QR Code COVID-19 Check-In system which is positioned at the church entry points.



The check-in process is very simple:

- 1) On arrival, scan the new QR code that will be in the foyer with your camera app or the Service Victoria app.
- 2) Enter your name (for individuals, enter your **first & last name**; and for families the first name of each member separated by spaces please do not use commas followed by your **last name**.)
- 3) Enter your phone number.
- 4) Select 'Check-in to this location' and you're done!
- 5) The contact details will need to be entered on first use and should be remembered by your phone on your subsequent visits, so check-ins should be much quicker.

If you cannot scan the QR code, you can download the Service Victoria app from the Apple AppStore or Google Play.

For those parishioners who are unable to scan the QR code could you please seek assistance as there will be someone to assist you.

Please ensure you wear a face mask in Church unless you have a medical exemption. Social distancing (1 per 4 square metre rule) still applies within the Church but not within a family group. It would be most appreciated if you could arrive a little earlier to allow for the extra administrative duties to be attended to.

Thank you for your understanding and continued cooperation in these COVID challenging times.

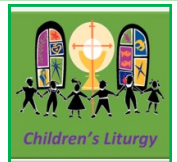


Anointing Mass for the Sick & Elderly
