

PALM SUNDAY REFELCTION

"Hosanna to the Son of David" they shouted Lord, as you entered Jerusalem—a people ecstatic, joyful and supportive in their welcome to you—their hope.

And yet Lord, you knew it all to be so shallow—their cheering, their rejoicing, their gaity, their warmth—all of this was to change.

Not over a few years,

Frist Reading: Is 50:4-7

The Lord has given me a disciple's tonque. So that I may know how to reply to the wearied he provides me with speech. Each morning he wakes me to hear, to listen like a disciple. The Lord has opened my ear. For my part, I made no resistance, neither did I turn away. I offered my back to those who struck me. my cheeks to those who tore at my beard; I did not cover my face against insult and spittle. The Lord comes to my help, so that I am untouched by the insults. So, too, I set my face like flint; I know I shall not be shamed.
