### PALM SUNDAY REFLECTION

“Hosanna to the Son of David” they shouted Lord, as you entered Jerusalem—a people ecstatic, joyful and supportive in their welcome to you—their hope.

And yet Lord, you knew it all to be so shallow—their cheering, their rejoicing, their gait, their warmth—all of this was to change.

Not over a few years,  
but over a matter of days.

This welcoming crowd on a warm Sunday morning were to be given an option on the Friday one man was to go free—and it was not you that they chose.

Why did they do that to you, Lord?

They'd seen you work miracles,  
the blind saw, the lame walked,  
the diseased and frightened were healed,  
and the hearts of so many were alive and burning—  
filled with your words of hope.

And yet when put to the test they failed you—their faith forgotten—and in fear they called for the release of Barabbas.

Two thousand years later we hear the story again, and somehow a cord is struck within us.

Is there something similar between us and ‘they’?

Do we welcome and reject as quickly as they did, Lord?

Do we try to shape and mould you into the Lord we like—

a Lord we can turn to in our need,

a Lord who can touch us when we are open to that and shut you out  
and turn you off when your presence frustrates

and hampers the we,

that we want to be.

Is it true Lord, that although times change, deep down people don't?

Haven't we learnt anything in two thousand years—your love goes

on, your presence just as real and still we are not all that we should

be. If only we were not they, Lord. If only...

**Frist Reading: Is 50:4-7**

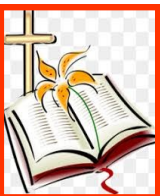
**A reminder to return your Project Compassion boxes and envelopes on Holy Thursday.** It would assist us greatly, if any coin donates are changed to notes.
