'I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.' Matthew 28:16-20

Matthew 28:16-20, often referred to as the **Great Commission**, is a powerful passage where Jesus gives His final instructions to His disciples before ascending to heaven. This passage is not just a directive but a profound inspiration for all believers:

Love as the Foundation: Jesus' authority and command in this passage are grounded in His love for humanity. It is an invitation born out of Jesus's deep love and desire for all people to experience the fullness of life in Him.

This act signifies a new beginning, an entry into a community of believers where God's love can be experienced and shared. The ongoing teaching and nurturing aspect of discipleship further reflects the transformative journey of growing in God's love.

Love in Presence: Jesus' promise, "And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age", is a declaration of His abiding love. His perpetual presence with believers is a source of comfort, strength, and assurance. Knowing that Jesus is always with us reinforces the understanding that His love is constant and unwavering, guiding us in our mission.

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the great love You have shown us through Jesus Christ. Empower us to fulfill the Great Commission with hearts full of Your love. Help us to reach out to all nations, baptise, and teach with compassion and grace. May we always feel your presence with us, guiding and strengthening us. In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen

First Reading: Deuteronomy 4:32-34. 39-40

Moses said to the people: 'Put this question to the ages that are past, that went before you, from the time God created man on earth: Was there ever a word so majestic, from one end of heaven to the other? Was anything ever heard? Did ever a people hear the voice of the living God speaking from the heart of the fire, as you heard it, and remain alive? Has any god ventured to take to himself one nation from the midst of another by ordeals, signs, wonders, war with mighty hand and outstretched arm, by fearsome terrors – all this that the Lord your God did for you before your eyes in Egypt?

'Understand this today, therefore, and take it to heart: The Lord is God indeed, in heaven above as on earth beneath, he and no other. Keep his laws and commandments as I give them to you today so that you and your children may prosper and live long in the land that the Lord your God gives you for ever.'

Second Reading: Romans 8:14-17

Everyone moved by the Spirit is a son of God. The spirit you received is not the spirit of slaves bringing fear into your lives again; it is the spirit of sons, and it makes us cry out, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit himself and our spirit bear united witness that we are children of God. And if we are children we are heirs as well: heirs of God and coheirs with Christ, sharing his sufferings so as to share his glory.

Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20

The eleven disciples set out for Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had arranged to meet them. When they saw him they fell down before him, though some hesitated. Jesus came up and spoke to them. He said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you. And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.'
