Third Sunday of Easter—Year B 14th April 2024

Embracing the transformative Power of Love—Luke 24:35-48

In Luke's Gospel, we witness a pivotal moment in the disciples' journey of faith following the resurrection of Jesus Christ. As they grapple with the astonishing news of his victory over death, Jesus appears among them, offering reassurance and illumination. What unfolds in this passage is not merely a reunion, but a profound revelation of love's transformative power and the fulfillment of divine promises.

At the heart of this passage lies the essence of love—a love that transcends earthly understanding and encompasses the very essence of God's nature. Jesus, in his resurrected form, stands before his disciples as a tangible manifestation of this love, dispelling their doubts and fears with his presence. His wounds bear witness to the depth of his sacrifice, a sacrifice made out of pure, selfless love for humanity.

In encountering Jesus, the disciples are not only confronted with the reality of his resurrection but also with the enduring truth of his message. He opens their minds to understand the Scriptures, revealing how everything that occurred was foretold and necessary for the fulfillment of God's plan of redemption. Through this revelation, the disciples are invited into a deeper intimacy with the Lord—a relationship grounded in love, faith and understanding.

Moreover, Jesus commissions his disciples to be witnesses of these events—to proclaim repentance and forgiveness of sins to all nations. This commission is rooted in love, extending the offer of salvation to every corner of the earth. It is a call to embody the love and compassion of Christ in our interactions with others, to be agents of reconciliation and bearers of hope in a world marred by brokenness and division.

As we reflect on this passage, we are invited to consider the profound implications of love in our own lives. Just as Jesus demonstrated love through his sacrifice and resurrection, we are called to emulate his example. We are called to love one another sacrificially, to forgive as we have been forgiven, and to extend grace to those in need. In doing so, we participate in the ongoing story of redemption and become vessels of god's love in a hurting world.

First Reading: Acts of the Apostles 3:13-15. 17-19

Peter said to the people: 'You are Israelites, and it is the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of our ancestors, who has glorified his servant Jesus, the same Jesus you handed over and then disowned in the presence of Pilate, after Pilate had decided to release him. It was you who accused the Holy One, the Just One, you who demanded the reprieve of a murderer while you killed the prince of life. God, however, raised him from the dead, and to that fact we are the witnesses.

'Now I know, brothers, that neither you nor your leaders had any idea what you were really doing; this was the way God carried out what he had foretold, when he said through all his prophets that his Christ would suffer. Now you must repent and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out.'

Second Reading: 1 John 2:1-5

I am writing this, my children, to stop you sinning: but if anyone should sin, we have our advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ, who is just; he is the sacrifice that takes our sins away, and not only ours, but the whole world's. We can be sure that we know God only by keeping his commandments. Anyone who says, 'I know him', and does not keep his commandments, is a liar. refusing to admit the truth. But when anyone does obey what he has said, God's love comes to perfection in him.

Gospel Reading: Luke 24:35-48

The disciples told their story of what had happened on the road and how they had recognised Jesus at the breaking of bread.

They were still talking about all this when Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, 'Peace be with you!' In a state of alarm and fright, they thought they were seeing a ghost. But he said, 'Why are you so agitated, and why are these doubts rising in your hearts? Look at

my hands and feet; yes, it is I indeed. Touch me and see for yourselves; a ghost has no flesh and bones as you can see I have.' And as he said this he showed them his hands and feet. Their joy was so great that they could not believe it, and they stood dumbfounded; so he said to them, 'Have you anything here to eat?' And they offered him a piece of grilled fish, which he took and ate before their eyes.



Then he told them, 'This is what I meant when I said, while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses, in the Prophets and in the Psalms, has to be fulfilled.'

He then opened their minds to understand the scriptures, and he said to them, 'So you see how it is written that the Christ would suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, and that, in his name, repentance for the forgiveness of sins would be preached to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem.

You are witnesses to this.
