# **LOVE OF GOD & NEIGHBOUR**

It has been my experience over many years, that whenever a young couple are given a choice of readings for their marriage service, they are highly likely to choose 1 Corinthians:13. As a trained Pharisee, Paul knew well the Scriptures and its teachings, and it is here that he gifts us with his famous commentary on LOVE. "I may be able to speak the languages of men and even angels, but if I have no love, my speech is no more than a noisy gong or a clanging bell." "Love," Paul adds, "is patient and kind, it is not jealous or conceited or proud; love is not ill-mannered or selfish or irritable,...love never gives up..."

Just like Paul, Jesus knew the Scriptures well, and when a Scribe asked, "Which is the first and most important commandment", it is to the Book of Deuteronomy, (6:5) that he turned, where we find the important statement on love of God, so dear to devout Jews: "You shall love your God with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your mind." This, says Jesus is the most important Commandment. He then gave his friend a bonus: "The second is like it," added Jesus, and promptly quoted from the book of Leviticus. (19:18) "You shall love your neighbour as yourself."

By bringing together these two commandments, Jesus teaches us that love of God and love of neighbour must seen as one commandment. Years later, the apostle John wound remind his hearers that "If one says he loves God but does not love his neighbour is a liar." The proof of our love of God whom we cannot see, is in our love of neighbour whom we can
