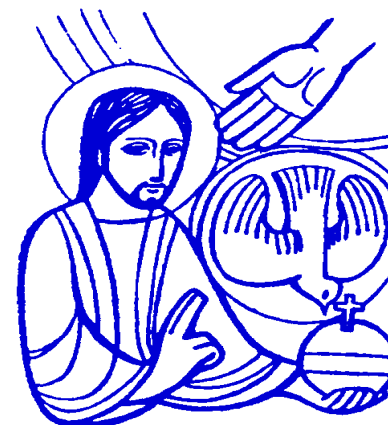

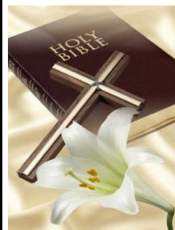
PENSIERO DOMENICALE

HOW GOD LOVES US

The past three Sundays have been marked with the major events of the Resurrection of Jesus, the Ascension and Pentecost, with which Jesus fulfilled his promise that he would not leave us orphans, but that he would send us the Paraclete, the Holy Spirit who would confirm all that he had taught us. Today the three persons of the Trinity come together almost as the three members of a choir adding their voices to the one song of love. We are aware, of course that we were first introduced to the Trinity at the baptism of Jesus, when a dove appeared above him while a voice from heaven proclaimed him as the beloved Son to whom we ought to listen.

We often begin the Eucharist in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, but today we are invited to reflect on this divine life of communion and perfect love, the love which invites us all to, *love one another as Jesus has loved us*, which should be the hallmark that distinguishes us as followers of Jesus: *"by this shall everyone know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."* We are called, therefore to witness to the love of a God who isn't far or insensitive to our joys, our sorrows and our struggles. Love is the reason Jesus became human, one of us, so that we would experience first hand the deep love God has for us, a love which is never taken away, no matter what. Thus revealing an otherwise all-powerful God who is incapable of suspending his love not only for us but for the whole of creation. "A love," comments Pope Francis, "which knows how to limit itself, to interact with others and to respect the freedom of everyone."

Today we can conclude appropriately with St Paul in today's letter to the Corinthians, *"The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all."*
