E la voce celeste - "Questi è il Figlio mio prediletto" è il sigillo perfetto a quella domanda.

THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

Peter, James and John saw Jesus transfiguration on the mountaintop that day. This means his appearance changed as his face and clothes shone like the sun.

What happens if the sun shines in our eyes? We are dazzled by its brightness and the strength of its light. The light shining from Jesus was as bright as the sun. These rays of light were shafts of God's glory and a glimpse of his power and might.

Can we see or touch the light from the sun? We cannot look at the sun's light directly because its brightness is too powerful for our eyes. We see its lights when it reflects off the things around us, things which cannot be seen once darkness falls. We cannot touch sunlight, but we can feel the warmth of its rays.

So it is with God. We cannot see or touch him directly, but we see him reflected in everything around us, the whole of creation, and we can feel the warmth of his love in our lives.

By what they saw and heard that day, the disciples caught a glimpse of God's glory. They were chosen to share a moment of total happiness and wonder. The memory of that vision would fill them with courage and strength, because they knew that Jesus was indeed the son of God.
