# THOMAS, THE DOUBTING DISCIPLE

Most of us have known the disciple Thomas as 'the doubting one'. but are we sure whether Thomas was in fact the only doubting disciple? Saint John informs us that on the evening of the same day, the day of his resurrection, Jesus called on his disciples who were still behind closed doors in the house where they had eaten their last meal together. He greeted them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit, as the Father sent me, so I am sending you." Does Saint John see this as the birth of the Church?

The following Sunday Jesus called again. The disciples were still in the same house, and we are told that on this occasion Thomas was also there. Jesus invited Thomas to see and touch. It was then that Thomas made his famous faith statement, "My Lord and my God." It is worth noting that while Thomas believed when he first saw Jesus, the disciples might still have had some doubts. Perhaps this is why they were still hiding behind close doors!

We should feel comfortable in the experience of the first disciples who had some difficulty in believing. It speaks to us of our own difficulties. Their story invites us to receive the gift of the Spirit, to leave the security of close doors, and to accept our mission to preach the Good News.
