SERVICE

Service, help, aid to those in need is something most of us do quite naturally. For us Catholics it is something which could be part or our D.N.A., something which is integral to our baptism, our identity as followers of Christ. In today's reading from the ACTS of the APOSTLES, the Apostles are seen to be very concerned about the situation in which widows find themselves: left destitute with the death of their husbands they can only survive through someone's charity.

It is obvious that the Apostles have made the care of widows a prime concern, but there appears to be so many that they are actually having to give up some of their preaching to this worthy cause. Rather that cut down on one or the other, they simply invent a service which we now call DIACONATE. They would devote all their time and effort in caring for the widows and other needy people. A number of suitable young men were chosen for this purpose. Now both the preaching and the service to the needy are proceed hand in hand.

These days Deacons are not ordained for this purpose, but the Church continues to provide service to the needy in many and varied ways. In Australia we can think of the many Catholic hospitals and the work of the St Vincent the Paul Society just as an example, while as individuals we are always reminded of our duty of service which emanates from the invitation which is given to us at the end of Mass: **Go in peace to love and serve the Lord.**
