WHO ARE MY FAMILY?

None of the evangelists spend much time in informing us about Jesus' daily routine, when he ate, when and how much he slept. But we are told so indirectly when we learn that he was so busy that he didn't have even enough time to sleep, spending every awake moment of the day ministering to the needs of the people whom he once described as "sheep without a shepherd."

In the Gospel today we see him fend off accusations from the Pharisees that he might actually have been casting out devils by the power of the devil himself. To some listeners, at least, he might have appeared as though he had lost his way, too exhausted to think clearly. Perhaps he needed a good rest.

His family seemed to think so, because they came as a group, "Your mother, sisters and brothers are asking for you," he was told. Jesus, however has not lost it at all, and as he had done on similar occasions, he took the opportunity to teach everyone a lesson, "Who are my mother and my brothers? Anyone who does the will of God, that person is my brother and sister and mother."
