PENSIERO DOMENICALE

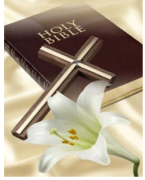

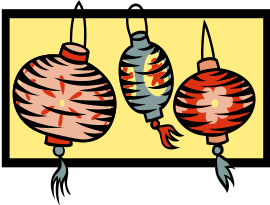

LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOUR AS YOU LOVE YOURSELF

In today's reading, St Paul reminds us that the Ten Commandments may be summarised by Love of God and love of our neighbour. He also reminds us that God has given us a model by which we are to love of neighbour: we are to love "AS YOU LOVE YOURSELF." While we may warm to loving our brothers and sisters, we may not be quite so comfortable with loving ourselves. This is possibly the result of our upbringing and indirectly by Church practice, which would suggest that loving ourselves could indicate an inflated ego; after all we are all sinful people. But it is precisely because we are sinful people and in need of forgiveness that God loves us. And so, just as God loves each one of us out of our sinfulness, we should find it more acceptable to love others "as we love ourselves".
